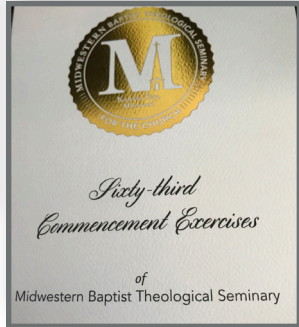

VOLUNTEER DAY!

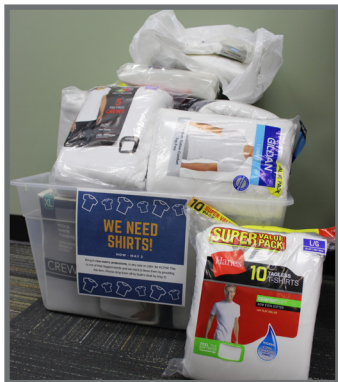
KANSAS CITY
