



## WINDOWS UPDATE

In January of 2020, Microsoft will be ending their support of Windows 7. This could impact your organization if you still have a computer running on that version. The suggestions from Microsoft are to either upgrade your current computer(s) - around \$150 - or to purchase a new computer that will come equipped with the newest version of Windows.

The other impact for your organization, is with MM Remote Access. Beginning in January, our office will not be able to guarantee that Remote Access will work with Windows 7 platforms. We suggest that you migrate your computers to Windows 10.
