"The Night Before the Numbers"

Getting ready for a finance meeting with your board isn't just about spreadsheets—it's a balancing act between data wrangling, storytelling, and staying calm under pressure.

You chase down scattered numbers from different systems, translate financial jargon into human language, and try to craft a narrative that ties every dollar to your mission. All while wondering if you should've started this days (or weeks) ago.

It's stressful. It's overwhelming. And it always takes longer than it should.

But when you finally click save on that board deck—tired but proud—you're reminded: this isn't just about money. It's about building trust, telling your story, and making sure the mission moves forward.

STAFF SPOTLIGHT: DELANEY


