What might we let go of to make room for new growth?

## 5. Stewardship & Resources

How did we steward finances, time, and energy this year?

Were we generous and faithful with what we were given?

What rhythms or systems need strengthening for sustainability?

## 6. Vision for the Year Ahead

What is God inviting us to focus on in the coming year?

If our ministry had one “ word ” or “ theme ” for the next season, what would it be — and why?

What would “ faithfulness ” look like one year from now?

How can we prepare our hearts and plans for what ’ s next?

## 7. Prayer of Commitment
